

Reading Task Card 1

Find the **meanings** of the words you do not know. Once you've done that write sentences of your own which use each of the words.

Reading Task Card 2

Before you finish the book, write down your **predictions** for the ending.

After you finish, check back and check the accuracy of your prediction.

Reading Task Card 3

How did the book **make you feel** when you were reading it?

Explain your answer.

Reading Task Card 4

Write a description of the **main character**: their looks, the way they dress, the way they talk and their personality

Reading Task Card 5

Imagine you are one of the characters in the story.

Write a **diary entry** that reflects thoughts and feelings about an event in his/her life.

Reading Task Card 6

Write about a **memory or experience** of your own that is similar to something you've read in the book.

Reading Task Card 7

Find **adjectives** in the text.

Make a list of them. Then, make up some sentences. Each sentence must contain at least 3 of the adjectives.

Reading Task Card 8

Think of 5 questions you would like to ask one of the **characters**.

Swap these with someone else in your group and write the answers as if you were that character.

Reading Task Card 9

Imagine you are an *Agony Aunt* in a magazine. Write some advice to the character having problems in the story.

Reading Task Card 10

Summarise the last section of the book you read **OR** if you have completed the book, as a challenge, you can **summarise** the whole book!
